Summary of Min Zhao's report

Dr. Zhao visited Integrated Substances Abuse Program (ISAP) at UCLA from June 22-29:

By observing research activities, meeting with clinicians, researchers and other colleagues at ISAP, information was exchanged with each other

Established International colaborative relationship with Drs. Walter Ling and Yih-Ing Hser and other scientists at UCLA. Preliminary collaborative research plan with Dr. Hser: To work on a Chinese version of ASI and study its validity and reliabitiy in Chinese populations

Visited the methadone clinics: During the visit, Dr. Zhao participated one group session

Summary of Min Zhao's report

Visited one of the Matrix treatment clinics and learned more about the Matrix Model, a 28-weeks intensive outpatient psychosozial treatment mainly on non-opioid abusers

Attended lectures by Dr. Hedeker from University of Illinois at Chicago about Mixture Model of longitudinal study


